


MORE INTELLIGENCE TO 'SEND OFF' CARGO CRIMINALS...

We recorded more incidents in 2021 - but the majority of cargo crimes are still not reported to TAPA EMEA... we need a team effort to gain more intelligence.

- 7,883 cargo theft incidents in 2021, +9% vs. the total in the 2020 Cargo Theft Annual Report
- Losses recorded in 56 countries across the region
- Less than 13% of reports gave a loss value
- Total loss for incidents with a value: > € 100,000,000
- Average loss for major crimes: > €890,000
- Average daily loss in 2021: > €275,000
- Incident date sources: Members (53.5%), LEAs (39.8%), Media (6.7%)





SETTING NEW STANDARDS...

Even despite the certification disruption caused by Covid, each Security Standard has seen growth in companies adopiting FSR, TSR and PSR in the last year... and certifications will continue to grow






