Entries will be judged on their originality, complexity, innovative solutions, and success in improving supply chain resilience for the applicants' companies or clients. All entries will be judged by members of the TAPA EMEA and TT Club leadership teams and the winner will be invited to receive their award at TAPA EMEA's *RESILIENCE@RISK Conference* in Amsterdam on 12 & 13 June 2024.

PRIZE:

Travel and two night's accommodation in Amsterdam to attend the TAPA EMEA conference will be offered by TAPA EMEA and TT Club to the winner in addition to the Award trophy.
